All the children came to the hall then Sr. Thieng announced to children about the party. Never having had a party before, the hall was quiet so Banh have started with some team games. Then Santa came into the hall. He scared many children!! WHO WAS HE? WHAT WAS HE? Hahaha Some kids keep away from him. Gerald and Santa went out to take them in.
